The quilts will be sold at a live auction Saturday. \$100 is the minimum bid for each quilt and 100% of the proceeds will benefit PJ's Forgotten Children. (www.pjsforgottenchildren.com) Legacy batting has been donated by **Pellon Consumer Products**.

1. The challenge is open to individuals or groups. Fill out the form to request a kit and send it with a check payable to HMQS in the amount of \$15 to Leslie. The kit includes fabric, batting and one Saturday-only admission ticket to view the live auction. Kits will be distributed on a first- come first-served basis by the end of December 2009.

2. A recognizable amount of each of the ten (10) challenge fabrics must be used in the quilt top. The amount used of each fabric is at the discretion of the entrant. Up to three (3) other fabrics may be added. Groups must provide the backing fabric; however, leftover fabric from the top may be used. Additional challenge fabric may be purchased. A source list will be included in the kit. Only the Legacy batting provided by Pellon may be used.

3. The quilt may include embellishments of any kind, including, but not limited to: buttons, trinkets, charms, hand or machine embroidery, ribbon, appliqué or other attachments.

4. The quilt's perimeter must exceed 80" but may not exceed 240".

5. The quilt must be machine quilted. This includes long-arm, short-arm or domestic machines. The quilt may be quilted with thread(s) of choice.

6. The quilt must have a sewn-on fabric label sewn on at either bottom corner and must include the following information:

- a. "HMQS 2010 Riley Blake Designs Fabric Challenge Quilt"
- b. The name of the quilt.
- c. The name of the guild, bee or group, if applicable.
- d. The names of the individual designer(s), piecer(s), machine quilter(s) and any other participant.

7. The quilt must have a 4" hanging sleeve. It must be sewn onto the back of the quilt to allow the quilt to be easily hung by a traditional pole. It may

be made of challenge fabric, backing fabric or muslin.

8. The quilt will be retained by HMQS for an auction to benefit PJ's Forgotten Children. The maker(s) of the quilt may bid on any quilt. The minimum bid of each quilt will be \$100. No quilt may be purchased for less.

9. The quilts will be judged and awarded cash for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize based on overall appearance, skill, fabric usage and machine quilting. The prizes will be awarded Thursday evening at the awards ceremony. A ribbon will be awarded to each winning quilt and each participant.
