

HMQS 2013 Quilting Treasures Quilts for Veterans Challenge

The Quilting Treasures Quilts for Veterans Challenge features the "Liberty" fabric collection by Christine Adolph and 80/20 Cotton/Poly Batting sponsored by **Winline Textiles**. \$1,000 in cash will be awarded, sponsored by **Quilting Treasures**.

Cash Awards and Ribbons

1st Place - \$500

2nd Place - \$300

3rd Place - \$200

1. The challenge is open to individuals or groups. Print this form to request a kit and send it, with a check **payable to HMQS**, in the amount of \$20 to the address below. The kit includes fabric (six 1/2-yd and one 1 yd pieces), batting and quilt label. Kits will be distributed on a first-come first-served basis. **Individuals may only be involved in one quilt or group.**

2. A recognizable amount of each of the seven (7) challenge fabrics must be used in the quilt top, at the discretion of the entrant. Up to three (3) other fabrics may be added. Groups must provide the backing fabric; however, leftover fabric from the top may be used. Only the Winline Textiles 80/20 Cotton/Poly Batting, included in the kit, may be used.

3. The quilt must measure 60" x 72"

4. The quilt must be machine quilted.

This includes long-arm, short-arm or domestic machines. The quilt may be quilted with thread(s) of choice.

5. The quilt must have the included sewn-on fabric label on the back of the quilt at either bottom corner and must include the following information:

- "Quilts for Veterans Challenge 2013"
- Blank line for recipient's name.
- The name of the piecer & quilter.

6. Make a temporary label to be pinned onto the back of the quilt that states:

- "HMQS 2013 Quilting Treasures Quilts for Veterans Challenge."
- Name of the quilt.
- The name of the quilt, bee or group, if applicable.
- The name(s) of the individual piecer(s) machine quilter and any other participant.

7. The quilt must have a binding.

8. The quilt must have a 4" hanging sleeve made from challenge or backing fabric or muslin. It must be sewn to the back of

the quilt to allow the quilt to be easily hung by a traditional pole.

9. **2" x 2" swatches** of each added fabric must be attached to the finalized entry form upon quilt submission. Do not include fabrics from the provided kit.

10. All challenge quilts will be donated to a U.S. Veteran in the new Utah State Veterans Home — Payson.

11. The quilts will be judged and awarded cash for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize based on overall appearance, skill, fabric usage and machine quilting. Prizes will be awarded at the award ceremony Thursday, May 9th at 12:30 p.m. A ribbon will be awarded to each winning quilt and each participant.
